What You Need: Bandanna or something to cover up eyes with

What You Do:

During the Activity: Tie the bandanna around your child's eyes. Then hold their hand and carefully lead them around the room. Then switch roles. Tie the bandanna around your eyes and have your child lead you around the room.

What You Can Say:

Before the Activity: "Let's take turns leading and following! We will guide each other around the room while blindfolded."

After the Activity: "We did a great job leading each other, but let's go talk about who is the best leader to follow!"

GET WELL GREETING ACTIVITY

What You Need: "Get Well Postcards" Activity Page, cardstock, stickers, and crayons or markers

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Copy "Get Well Postcards" on cardstock and cut on dotted lines (one postcard per child). Set all the postcards, stickers, and markers or crayons on the table.

During the Activity: Point out the words on the front of the card. Encourage the children to decorate the back of the card with the supplies provided.

After the Activity: Gather all cards, markers, crayons, and any extra stickers for clean-up.

What You Say:

Before the Activity: "Today we're going to make some special cards for people in the hospital. It's so nice to show love to someone when they aren't feeling well! On the front of this card, it says, 'Love one another!' Let's show some love by decorating the back of our cards, and then we'll give them to people who are in the hospital to show we are thinking about them and that we love them."

After the Activity: "These are beautiful. I know they will make so many people feel so loved. Thank you for helping make these special cards today. Making a card for someone is just one way to show love. We'll hear more about how Jesus loves in our Bible story today. Let's go!"

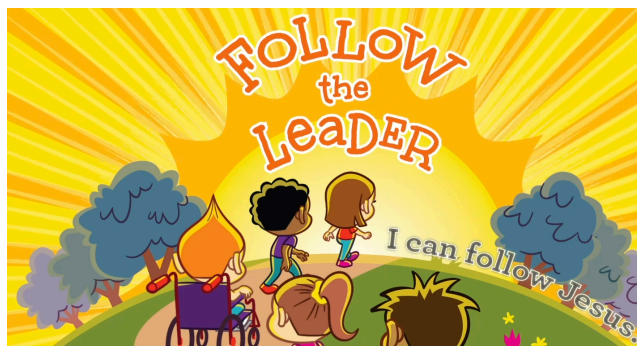
BIBLE STORY VIDEO

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CRAFT

HEART CUTOUT

What You Need: Construction paper, marker, and preschool-safe scissors

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Cut the paper into four equal squares. Fold each square in half. Draw half of a heart with the middle of the heart at the fold.

During the Activity: Give each child a folded square and a pair of scissors. Instruct the child to cut on the outline of the heart.

After the Activity: Help the children unfold their cutouts to reveal the heart.

What You Say:

Before the Activity: "We are going to practice our cutting."

During the Activity: (Give each child a folded square.) "Use the scissors to cut on the line." (Do activity.)

After the Activity: "Great job! Let's unfold the cutout and see what it is! (Finish activity.) It is a heart! A heart is about love. Jesus wants us to follow Him and love one another! Who can you follow? [Bottom Line] I can follow Jesus."
